Once the committee has read what you have submitted, they may invite each applicant to a brief personal interview.

**NOTIFICATION**

The committee will announce final decisions to all candidates by E-mail and telephone.

**PRESENTATION**

The Clinton F. and Naomi B. Larson Scholarship will be presented at the annual English Awards Banquet, April 2010.
