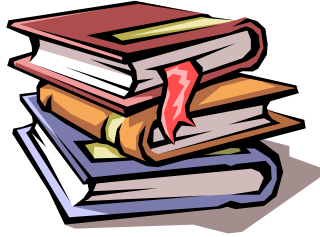


Operations of Intelligent Behavior
